16/17/117	PUBLIC SESSION A member of the public spoke in relation to the consultant report on the speed reduction scheme the Hanwood. There has been pressure to have more signage but the report is erring towards de-cluttering of signage and this the removal of white in Hanwood Bank. The member of the public saw this is a good idea. It was suggested that a sign notifying people that this is a Community Speedwatch area would be useful. It was further noted that the proposed lining changes would lead to a narrowing of Post Office Lane - this is problematic as it creates issues for road users and will encourage right turns; the bin lorry also turns here.
16/17/118	CARADOC VIEW PLAY AREA It was RESOLVED to apply for an £8000 grant from Veolia towards replacing the wooden trim trail. It was RESOLVED to approve the repairs proposed by Sovereign Playgrounds. It was further RESOLVED not to carry out maintenance to the Creative Play swings at present as the works are not urgent and it was possible that the swings could be moved as part of the replacement of the trim trail.
