16/17/124	<p>ATTENDANCE & APOLOGIES The clerk reported that Cllrs. Jones has resigned.</p>
16/17/125	<p>DECLARATIONS OF DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS & DISPENSATION REQUESTS None declared and no dispensations being sought.</p>
16/17/126	<p>PUBLIC SESSION</p> <p>i. Public comments - Silvia Grant gave an update in relation to a community project to look at purchasing The Cock Inn and Bowling Green, as part of the moratorium process. She advised that a steering group has been set up to assess the feasibility of doing this; the steering group consists of Silvia, Bill Longmore and a representative of the Bowling Green. Community grants are available to assist with the purchase and other sources of funding may be available as well. The Green cannot be purchased by the bowling club so a Community Interest Company will be set up and the community could buy shares in the company.</p> <p>The next step is to consult with the residents in Hanwood by means of a survey. There are no planned uses as yet for the site. Silvia confirmed that a post office / shop was not one of the uses proposed on the survey. Councillor Davies asked if Punch Taverns are seeking £275,000? The Council expressed concern that the deadline for making a bid for the community assets is June to July and the project is still in its early stages. Silvia advised that the timeline is that after the questionnaire has been distributed, the group will report back to the Plunkett Foundation (who offer grant funding) and CAMRA for help with outstanding issues, such as what type of social enterprise structure to have. A business plan will be drawn up and fundraising and share issue plans will also be considered. Silvia said that a formal</p>

	<p>committee will be set up. The group were invited to attend the Annual Parish Meeting to give a further update on progress. Councillor Evans said that in his opinion the parish council would want the pub to be kept. The clerk was asked to publicise the survey online.</p> <p>ii. Police report - 3 ASB, one violence, one burglary, one vehicle crime.</p> <p>iii. Shropshire Councillor report - Councillor Evans reported that he had attended a march in town which was in relation to schools and the withdrawal of grant funding. This will lead to Shropshire Council removing £640,000 of funding for schools in addition apprenticeship levy is being charged.</p> <p>Councillor Evans advised that youth funding has been confirmed until December and working group continues to look at this issue. Consultations on the economic strategy leisure strategy are forthcoming.</p> <p>Shropshire Council has increased its precept by 3.99% did not opt to increase by an extra 1%, for adult social care, as there are strings attached to this money in summary, it is to be used for putting in place future arrangements rather than current costs. The work to me a brace roundabout is going ahead and councillor Evans is questioned why it needs to go ahead.</p> <p>iv.</p>
